


NATIONAL ACHIEVEMENT SURVEY



MATHEMATICS PARK

Mathematics is a very interesting subject, which is really required in our day-to-day life but still for children it is always the most fearful subject. So, to ensure quality education and remove the fear of mathematics from children's minds, a school teacher from Paikmal block in Bargarh has developed a first-of-its-kind 'Maths Park' on the premises of the government primary school in his village Pujharipali.

Subash Chandra Sahu, a cluster resource centre coordinator (CRCC) of Lakhmara panchayat in the district, has developed the park to teach maths to children in a fun-filled interactive manner. The park has coloured rocks, canopies & benches which represent different geometrical shapes, numbers and along with that there are wall paintings depicting information about various mathematicians and theorems.

This park became operational two months back & it is designed to keep the children engaged and make them learn while playing. Since schools reopened after a long time, it has become difficult for students to focus in classrooms but they are spending time doing sums and learning tables in this park. So, it has turned into a centre of attraction for children.

The park has not only been drawing children of Pujharipali primary school but also students from neighbouring schools & Chhattisgarh. Sahu's innovative approach to learning has given the Pujharipali village a unique identity as far as primary education. In 2020, when schools were closed due to the COVID-19 outbreak, Sahu had painted learning materials on various topics like: - Alphabets, Numbers & Freedom Fighters and hung those charts on trees & started teaching the village children.

We hope that SAHU will be successful in his quest of making learning easy.

A Report on BITM

BIRLA INDUSTRIAL & TECHNOLOGICAL MUSEUM in Kolkata, the temple of Science & technology is the first Science museum in the country under the National Council of Science Museum, Ministry of Culture, Government of India established under the initiative of Dr. Bidhan Chandra Roy with support of Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru & Shri Ghanshyam Das Birla, inaugurated on 2nd May, 1959. This place has the memories related to Rabindranath Tagore. In the post pandemic period, the authority has reopened the renovated museum for promoting Science & Technology specially amongst the school children.

Vaccination camp for the age group of 12-14 years was organized by the school on 24 June 2022. This brought us a step ahead to brave the Covid virus.







RATHYATRA CELEBRATED IN SCHOOL


